Dr. Kent Bramlett is Professor of Archaeology and the History of Antiquity at La Sierra University, having earned his PhD at the University of Toronto in Near Eastern archaeology. He is also Assoc. Director of CNEA and co-directs the Balu`a Regional Archaeological Project in Jordan.

Dr. Peter J. Brand is Professor in the Department of History at the University of Memphis, having earned his PhD at the University of Toronto. Brand is widely published in subjects like Egyptian kingship, monumental art and construction, religion, and warfare, and has appeared on more than 20 filmed documentaries.





Dr. Kara Cooney is a Professor of Egyptology at UCLA and Chair of the Department of Near Eastern Languages and Cultures, specializing in social history, gender studies, and economies in the ancient world. She earned her PhD in Egyptology from Johns Hopkins University and is recognized globally for her lectures and publications.

Dr. James K. Hoffmeier is Emeritus Professor of Near Eastern Archaeology at Trinity International University's Divinity school, having earned a PhD at the University of Toronto. A prolific author and lecturer, he has dedicated his long career to understanding Egyptian history and its relationship to ancient Israel.





Dr. Steven Ortiz is director of the newly established Lanier Center for Archaeology at Lipscomb University where he is also a professor of archaeology and biblical studies. Having earned his PhD at the University of Arizona, he has published widely and currently directs excavations at Tel Gezer in Israel.
