#### PROCESS FOR CLEAR CREDENTIAL

Two year process: The Clear Credential Program takes 3 summers to complete.

Summer 1: Meet with an advisor to plan your individualized program. Take EDCI 595 Clear Credential

Orientation, EDCI 511 Advanced Health and Safety in Education and EDCI 550 Instructional Models and Origins of Learning.

Fieldwork year 1: Develop a Professional Growth Plan. Teach full-time in your own classroom in a WASC approved school. Interact regularly with Clear Credential Supervisors/Mentors.

Summer 2: Take EDCI 513 Advanced Study of Teaching English Language Learners and EDCI 565 Advanced Special Education in the Regular Classroom. Meet with your advisor for evaluation/progress report.

Fieldwork year 2: Continue the process of professional development through planning, reflection, and implementation while teaching in your own classroom. Interact regularly with Clear Credential Supervisors/

Summative assessment: Complete EDCI 596 Clear Credential Portfolio and receive a summative assessment by the advisor/supervisor.
