With so many requirements to check off your list before dental school, you need to map out the next four years. Use the following checklist to guide you through the years you will spend here at La Sierra University and ensure you are on the right track for your future career as a dentist.

YEAR ONE -Verify you are declared as "pre-dentistry" to ensure you receive all communication sent out to pre-dent students. YEAR TWO -Join clubs that are relevant to your interests such as "Pre-Dental Society". -Keep taking your pre-dent requirements, meet with your -Create an academic plan on your computer or planner to academic advisor to ensure you are on track. remind yourself of what prerequisites you need to take. -Narrow down your extracurriculars to those that excite you -Become familiarized with the resources OACS provides to most.
