**CAREER OPPORTUNITIES AND RELATED OCCUPATIONS:** The physical therapist assistant is a skilled technical health worker who, under supervision of a physical therapist, assists in the patients' treatment program. The extent to which the physical therapist assistant is involved in treatment depends upon the policies of the health facility, the supervising therapist, and the patient.

**EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:** One year at La Sierra University to complete the pre-requisites and one additional year in a Physical Therapy Assistant program.

When professional training is completed the candidate is eligible to take the licensing exam.

**JOB OPPORTUNITIES:** It is expected that job availability will grow by 44% through 2014. Physical therapist assistants are in demand and graduates have a wide choice of opportunities with medical groups, hospitals, rehabilitation centers, outpatient clinics, national and state agencies, and schools of physical therapy.

**SALARY:** The median annual wage for physical therapist assistants was \$52,160 in May 2012. The median wage is the wage at which half the workers in an occupation earned more than that amount and half earned less. The lowest 10 percent earned less than \$32,420, and the top 10 percent earned more than \$72,720. The median annual wage for physical therapist aides was \$23,880 in May 2012. The lowest 10 percent earned less than \$17,540, and the top 10 percent earned more than \$35,420. Most physical therapist assistants and aides work full time. Many physical therapy offices and clinics have evening and weekend hours to accommodate patients' schedules.
